36" x 36" Finished Quilt 6" finished block

Options: Sofa (50" x 71"), Twin (71" X 92"), Queen (85" x 92"), King (99"x99")

All sizes include optional border.

Introduction

Create a celestial host of these adorable 3D angels from scraps or any collection of fabrics that give a festive air. Learn a simple trick to sew the angel's 3D head and the entire block with only 7 straight seams. Create the illusion of a pieced border simply by using darker backgrounds.



Materials

Use your scraps! This is a great pattern to use lots of smaller scraps (3 ½" triangles for the head, and two 3 ½" triangles or 4" x 4" square for the angel wings and skirt; four 3 ½" triangles or two 4" x 4" squares for the background for each block).

Fabric needed: The chart below shows the *minimum amount of fabric* you will need in the various value categories, in tenths of yards. One Fat Quarter (FQ) = .25 yds, 2 FQs = .5 yds, 3 FQ = .75 yds, 4 FQ= 1 yd.

You can also use charm packs or layer cakes.

Note that you will be making Light blocks for the body of the quilt and Dark blocks along the border.

Background - Med/Dark	0.4	0.8	1.1	1.2	1.3
Wings - Light or Med	0.2	0.4	0.6	0.6	0.7
Skirt - Light or Med	0.2	0.4	0.6	0.6	0.7
Head - Light or Med	0.1	0.2	0.3	0.3	0.4
Sashing - Dark	0.2	0.3	0.4	0.4	0.4
Borders – Dark (optional)	0.2	0.3	0.4	0.4	0.5
Binding - Dark	0.3	0.5	0.7	0.7	0.7

Supplies:

- Sewing Machine with regular feet, plus quarter inch foot if you have one
- Rotary cutter and mat
- Square ruler—6” or 6 ½” small square ruler with a diagonal line from point to point
- Optional half square triangle ruler if this is your preferred method – recommend Easy Angle
- Thread—neutral color such as beige or grey
- Basic sewing supplies—straight pins, seam ripper, thread snips, etc.
- Optional small iron and ironing pad if venue allows



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
